***I can add and subtract signed decimals.***

---

To add and subtract decimals, you must line up the decimals.

With signed decimals, follow the rules for integers.

Remember... When you are going to subtract, you still have to put the number with the biggest absolute value on top.

Examples:

1.  $5.67 + (-0.35)$

$$\begin{array}{r} 5.67 \\ -0.35 \\ \hline 5.32 \end{array}$$

2.  $-6.82 + (-8.47)$

$$\begin{array}{r} 6.82 \\ +8.47 \\ \hline -15.29 \end{array}$$

3.  $-0.6 + (-9.56)$

$$\begin{array}{r} 0.60 \\ +9.56 \\ \hline -10.16 \end{array}$$

4.  $-4.821 + 3.2$

$$\begin{array}{r} 4.821 \\ -3.200 \\ \hline -1.621 \end{array}$$

5.  $3.18 + (-7.92)$

$$\begin{array}{r} 7.92 \\ -3.18 \\ \hline -4.74 \end{array}$$

6.  $-8.25 + 8.14$

$$\begin{array}{r} 8.25 \\ -8.14 \\ \hline -0.11 \end{array}$$

7.  $-21.45 - 6.781 + 2.71$

$$-21.45 + (-6.781) + 2.71$$

$$-25.521$$

8.  $3.003 + (-2.56) - 3$

$$3.003 + (-2.56) + (-3)$$

$$-2.557$$

9.  $-10.45 + (-23.6) - (-2.64)$

$$-10.45 + (-23.6) + 2.64$$

$$-31.41$$

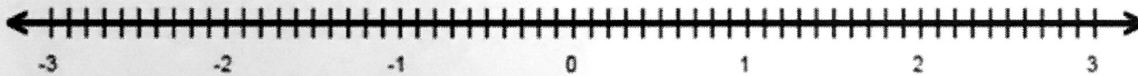

The distance between any two points on the number line is the absolute value of their difference.

Use the number lines to find the distances between the points.



a) -2.5 and -1.3

$$|-2.5 - (-1.3)| = 1.2$$

$$|-1.3 - (-2.5)| = 1.2$$

b) -0.8 and 1.2

$$|-0.8 - 1.2| = 2$$

$$|1.2 - (-0.8)| = 2$$

c) 1.2 and 2.9

$$|1.2 - 2.9| = 1.7$$

$$|2.9 - 1.2| = 1.7$$

d) -3.5 and -1.2

$$|-3.5 - (-1.2)| = 2.3$$

$$|-1.2 - (-3.5)| = 2.3$$
